

Personal Emergency Service Bag

These items are suggestions. Create your service bag with items you see as important from this list and other lists you find online. Many items you will already have for camping. Store these items in your service bag. Take them out temporarily for camping trips. Other items you will have around the house. If you are not able to purchase the items on your list right away, make a plan to acquire them over time.

- Backpack (an old school backpack might work)
- List of items in your bag (or will be in your bag)
- Poncho or raincoat
- Change of clothes
- Small bag with toiletries, needle & thread, toilet paper
- Sleeping bag
- Map of area
- 50 feed nylon cord
- Pocket knife and ax and/or saw
- Water treatment equipment
- Cook kit and water bottle
- Flashlight
- Battery powered radio
- Extra batteries
- Hard hat
- Winter gloves, hat, rubber boots
- Personal first aid kit
- Matches, lighter, fire starters
- Emergency food
- Pencil and small notebook
- Bandanna
- Compass
- Watch
- Facial tissues
- Work gloves
- Dust mask
- Safety goggles

Mark your items with your last name or initials. Do not put your name on the outside of your bag but decorate it in a way to make it easily identifiable as yours. Putting our troop number on the outside may be helpful too.
